

# Scoop\_X 1.0

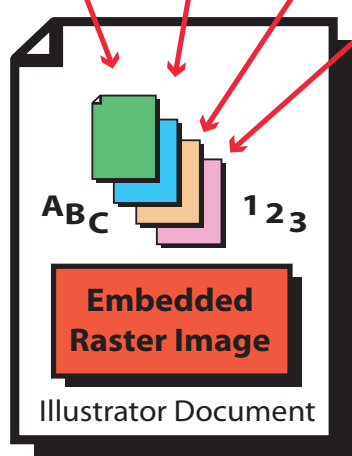
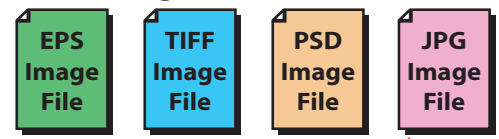
Scoop is an Adobe Illustrator version 10 plug-in for Mac OS 9 or 10, that will copy all fonts and placed images and extract all embedded images in an Illustrator document. New image files are placed into a new folder, created by Scoop, in the same folder as the original Illustrator document. Placed (linked) images are copied in their original format. Embedded images are extracted as TIFF files. Extracted rasters with an alpha channel (transparency) will not link to the images in Illustrator. They can, however be opened in PhotoShop and resaved as native PSD files that will link and maintain transparency. Scoop\_X works with Illustrator version 10 only. To install the software, simply copy it into your Illustrator plug-ins folder and launch Illustrator. The "Collect Images/Fonts" command will be under the File menu.

## Options

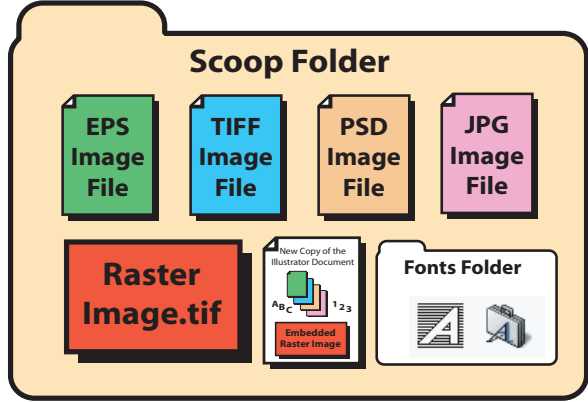
You can choose to collect only linked images, only embedded images or both for either the entire document or only the images you have selected. You can also choose to have the links updated to the newly collected image files. Fonts will be placed in a new folder inside the Scoop folder. "Include Application Support Fonts" will allow Scoop to copy the fonts installed by Illustrator. This would normally not be necessary if you were sending your document to another Illustrator user.



### Linked Images



- Copies Linked Files
- Collects Fonts in a Separate Folder
- Extracts Embedded Image as TIFF
- Saves a copy of the Illustrator Document
- Links Copied and Extracted Images in the New Illustrator Document



## Using Scoop\_X

- Activate needed fonts.
- Open the Illustrator document and update any links to placed files, if necessary.
- Save your file.
- If a placed image uses fonts not found in the rest of the document, embedding a copy of the image will allow those to be collected as well. The embedded copy can be deleted afterwards.
- Select "Collect Images/Fonts" under the File menu.
- Select desired Scoop options and click OK.
- A new folder will be created in the same folder as your Illustrator document that contains your collected images, the font folder and a copy of the Illustrator document.

### About Type 1 Fonts and suitcases

If you store the bitmap portion of a Type 1 font in a suitcase, Scoop\_X will copy the suitcase when collecting fonts. To avoid collecting unused bitmap fonts, it is recommended that they not be stored in a suitcase. If this is not practical, avoid storing more than one type family in a single suitcase.
